



General Information

All skaters must skate on the highest session they qualify for. There will be NO exceptions to this rule unless the board deems necessary. Movement to a higher session is only allowed in January 2010 provided the following conditions are met:

- 1) the skater must have passed the required tests in full
- 2) A letter from the skater and signed by their coach must be received by the Membership Chair before the December board meeting
- 3) There must be room on the session the skater is requesting to move to.

If a skater passes all the tests required for a higher level they must register in that level for the Spring Session.

Fundraising

Fundraising participation is required by every member and the amount is paid with your registration fees. This is capped at a maximum of \$100 per family. Other fundraisers are included throughout the skating season. Your support with this is greatly appreciated.

Music

Music is an important part of each session. **Operators** are necessary for the music room to run efficiently. All operators will receive a \$5/hour credit towards future registration.
