



## Music Room Regulations



### Frequently Asked Questions

#### **Who Plays the Skaters' Music?**

Operators who have been trained on the equipment play music at all sessions. Music Room operators follow Music Room Regulations and Policies as decided by Skate Canada Brampton-Chinguacousy.

#### **How is Music Played?**

Each session has its own session lists. Skaters' names are listed alphabetically. Music Room operators check the session lists for an indication of the last skater for whom music was played the previous session. Music will begin at various points in the list depending on which skater the last session left off with. Absences and skater's refusal to skate are noted, and their turn in the rotation is forfeited.

#### **Who can request music to be played?**

Only coaches are allowed to request music. Skaters and/or their parents are not allowed to request solos, dances, or skills. Coaches may request their skater's music once every 15-minute lesson. A coach's request always supersedes music played in rotation.

#### **Can a skater's music be requested more than once?**

If a skater has two or more lessons on a session, their music can be requested more than once.

#### **Who is responsible for ensuring the skater's music is in the Music Room?**

It is the skater's responsibility to ensure that their most recent music is in the Music Room. Skaters should remember to return their music after any competitions.

#### **What happens once a skater's music is announced?**

When the skater's hear their name announced, they should put on the designated armband and mover quickly to their skating position. Skater's skating their solo music have right of way. All other skaters are to yield right of way. Coaches and parents are asked to remind their skaters to move quickly to their starting positions. Safety is a priority at Skate Canada Brampton-Chinguacousy and occasional reminders will be made to ensure skater cooperation.
